

- SouthCoast Development Partnership, located at UMass Dartmouth, was allocated \$250,000
- The Advanced Technology Manufacturing Center (ATMC), located on Martine St. in Fall River, will receive \$1.58 million
- The Bristol County Child Advocacy Center, located in downtown Fall River, will receive \$187,000 for its fledgling operation
- \$150,000 to dredge the Westport River
- The International Trade Assistance Center, located in downtown Fall River, will receive \$185,000
- Battleship Cove will receive \$100,000 in state funding
- People Inc, located in Fall River, will receive \$50,000 to fund its Human Service Training Academy
- Language maintaining a Department of Revenue Office, Registry of Motor Vehicles, and Boat Titling Office in Fall River
- \$500,000 in funding for a Center for Portuguese Studies at UMass Dartmouth
- \$50,000 in funding for Center for Marketing Research at UMass Dartmouth
- Bristol County Veterans Association funded at \$100,000
- \$250,000 in funding for the Massachusetts Coalition for Juvenile Firesetters located in Fall River
- \$150,000 for supportive housing at the Edward F. Doolan Apartments in Fall River
- \$472 million for the Commonwealth Care Health Insurance program, to provide subsidized health insurance coverage to residents of Massachusetts with incomes less than 300 percent of the federal poverty level. This funding will allow nearly 150,000 residents to enroll in the program in fiscal year 2008.
- \$3.4 million increase for beaches, including Horseneck Beach in Westport, under the control of the Department of Conservation and Recreation; and
